

In 1820 a young sailor by the name of Henry Wolsey Bayfield was enlisted by the British Empire to conduct unnegotiated surveys within the territories of the Anishinaabe nations.

He travelled along the shores of what are known today as Lakes Huron and Superior, mapping and renaming thousands of islands and geographic features including the "Parry Sound" where the current town of Parry Sound is located.

## nstructions
